

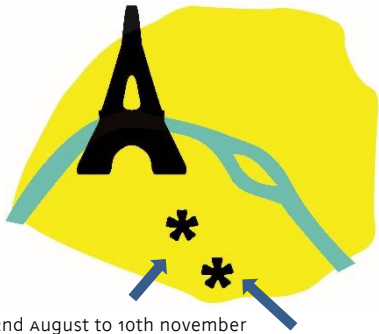

<p>► Health check and/or visa validation</p> <p>Officers of the office Français de l'immigration et de l'intégration (OFII) will make appointments, if you live in Paris and came with the "Long stay visa qualifying for a residency permit" (Ref: R311-3 6° of the CESEDA), to attend an obligatory health check and/or validate your visa. <p>► Financial housing assistance</p> <p>The staff from the Caisse d'Allocations Familiales (CAF) will help you complete and submit your online claims. <p>► Health insurance</p> <p>The staff from La Mutuelle des Étudiants (LMDE) and the Société Mutualiste des Étudiants de la Région Parisienne (SMERP) inform you on health care and complementary cover (refunding medical costs, applying for a health card (carte vitale) or declaring an attending physician.
