Residence permit officers from the préfecture de police de paris will inform vou and > **Initial student permit** (Algerian students living in paris), > Renewal of the student permit (**cité internationale residents only**).

> **Temporary stay permit (APS)** (only for Paris-based students).

нealth check and/or visa validation

officers of the office francais de l'immigration et de l'intégration (ofii) will make appointments, if you live in paris and came

with the "Long stay visa qualifying for a residency permit" (Ref: R311-3 6° of the CESEDA), to attend an obligatory health check

and/or validate your visa. This process is mandatory and must be carried out within 3 months after arriving in France.

Financial housing assistance
